Dram of <mark>Bushmills 10 y.o.</mark> (light, velvety-soft, fruity) at Karsten & Chris, Sunningdale

Last dram from the bottle of Clynelish 14 y.o. (lasted 1 year and 8 months)

Opened a mini from Christine & Tim's birthday-pack at home: Bowmore 10 y.o. (sweet-smoky, most smoke in the nose)

> 73 whiskies, of which 49 single malts plus 1 'edge of whisky' spirit and 2 whisky liqueurs

Dram of Balvenie 10 y.o. Founder's Reserve (full-sweet, supple, hints of vanilla) at home, part of the whisky chess board

Opened a bottle of Glen Kella 12 y.o. (spirity, but not much in terms of taste) at home; bottle may be one of the last bottles of Manx Whiskey sold, as J ordered it a week before the court case which ruled that Glen Kella can not be labelled 'whisky' as the maturation clock had been put back to zero by the re-distillation Opened a bottle of **Piraten Whisky** (very woody and dry, strangely fishyoily, sometimes bitter, sometimes bourbony) at home

Last dram from the bottle of **Bushmills 1608** (lasted 2 years and 2 months)

Opened a bottle of Macallan 12 y.o. at home

Last dram from the bottle of **Talisker 10 y.o.** (2 bottles; lasting 2 years and 9 months)

Opened a bottle of Bruichladdich 17 y.o. (light peat in the background) at home, pressie from Riannon

Dram of Teacher's Highland Cream at Karsten & Chris, Bracknell

Last dram from the bottle of Drambuie (lasted 1 year and 4 months)

97 whiskies, of which 67 single malts (1 new-make) plus 3 'edge of whisky' spirits and 2 whisky liqueurs

Last dram from the bottle of Laphroaig 10 y.o. (lasted 6 months)


Dram of **Glenlivet 12 y.o.** during Xmas Lunch, Silwood (bottle from *Christine*)
