# January

### Dram of Highland Park 12 y.o. at James & Sally, North Ascot

Tasting sessions at home with Jrma and Thomas for WM article on eaude-vie still whiskies. Opened bottles of St George, pressie from Lance when visiting the distillery; McCarthy's (peat and acid fruits, mango); Peregrine Rock (vanilla-sweet nose, very dry finish); Forty Creek Three Grain (vanilla, chocolate, toffee, pop corn, crisp, warming mouthfeel); Forty Creek Barrel Select (dark chocolate, nutty, caramel, warming mouthfeel), both Forty Creek bottles courtesy of Kittling Ridge distillery; Gold Cock 12 y.o. (full, butter, toffee-apples, velvety-soft), bottle courtesy of Likerka Dolany; Gersten-Malzwhisky (leather, vanilla, fructose); Roggen-Malzwhisky (pralines, mint, somewhat bitter, delicate); Hafer-Whisky 1998 (almonds, marzipan, oat flakes, very light); Lark '01 bottling (light, raspberries, hint of peat)

sweeter than Blaue Maus); Rabel Schwäbischer Whisky (porridge, burnt, rough, hint of sweetness, dusty); Zaiser Schwäbischer Whisky (applecrumble, butterscotch, toffee-creamy, honey mouthfeel); Black Horse Ammertal Whisky (fructose-sweetness, leather, vanilla-fudge, very light); Whisky aus dem Steigerwald (custard, chocolate, harsh, bitter)

Sherry Cask, Aberlour 15 y.o. Sherry Finish, Hazelburn 5 y.o. cask sample (too spirity, but full-flavoured), McKendric (orange and retsina), Ardbeg 25 y.o. Lords of the Jsles (delicate), Girvan 1964 and Springbank 10 y.o. Went home with a halffull bottle of Aberlour 15 y.o. Sherry Finish thanks to Neil MacDonald

Opened a sample bottle of Blaue Maus 1986 - 15 y.o. (7/86-5/02) (very bourbony nose, with hint of pickles; less sweet palate; finish falls away; very dark colour) at home; sample bottle courtesy of Robert Fleischmann

Dram of Bowmore 1989 Raw Cask, Blackadder (peaty and tarry with hints of sweetness, Rob, no FWP .....) at home, sample from Rob Stevens

Opened a mini from Christine & Enrique's birthday-pack at home: Longmorn 15 y.o. (fruity nose, apples, raspberries; full-firm body; slightest hint of smoke; long finish)

Last dram from the bottle of *Oban 1980 Distillers Edition* (lasted 1 year and 1 month)
